

How to report a complaint anonymously

Step 1:


Type the URL <https://www.cybercrime.gov.in> in the Web browser

Step 2:

Select **“Report Anonymously”** option, if you want to report an online Child Pornography (CP) - Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM) or sexually explicit content such as Rape/Gang Rape (CP/RGR) content without revealing your identity.



Read the message in the pop-up window and click on the “ok” button.

Step 4:

Provide the details as required for complaint reporting

- a. Select the “**Category of Crime**” (**Mandatory**) from the drop-down (two options are available in drop-down – 1. Rape/ Gang rape (RGR) – sexually abusive content, 2. Child Pornography (CP) - Child Sexually abusive material (CSAM)).
- b. Enter the Suspect details if known like
 - i. “Name of the suspect”
 - ii. Any other details (Source of information: Social media username or url, messaging app phone number (WhatsApp, Snapchat, JioChatetc.), E-Mail address from which questionable content was received or shared)

Enter the Crime incident details

- i. Select “Date of incident”
- ii. Enter the “Time of incident”
- iii. Select “State” (**Mandatory field**) – Select the victim’s location if known or your location.
- iv. Select District
- v. Select Police station
- vi. Fill in other information about the crime, if available that may help in the investigation
- vii. Enter the Information source through which it was received (like facebook,twitter,whatsapp,etc)
- viii. Upload evidence as attachment if any (Maximum allowable limit is 5 MB). After the above details are filled in the portal, enter the captcha and click on “**submit**” button.


